School Improvement Plan & Financial Update: Thank you to those who attended the school improvement plan planning day. The School Improvement plan was finalized and has been submitted to the School Board for approval. \$8,000 excess this year has been carried over to the budget for 2019-2020 school year. Currently in Davis School District, community councils combine the Land Trust plan with the School improvement plan. Starting next year, community councils will be in charge of the Land Trust plan and a school committee will oversee the school improvement plan. This legislative session, a new bill was passed granting schools additional funds beginning next school year. It is anticipated this will be approx. \$100/student. Brainstorming session of how to utilize these funds. Ideas included: Offsetting cost of AP exams, adding a bus for the Afterschool Program which includes tutoring—cost would be approx. \$16K; for attendance; Online Electives—can pilot this over the summer, unsure on cost after pilot; Replacing the most used classroom iPads; College Tours for those grades not included in the Gear up grant; Virtual Reality—classroom set is approx.. cost of one field experience for one grade level; Library—could use additional books to bring up to state recommendations; Jr. Achievement City

Counseling Department—Doing well.

After School Program: Play Pirates of Penzance Jr. will be April 19-20 & 22; Great Staff; have a grant for next year.

PTA: Looking for a president

Library: Won best video of School Stars--\$500 prize money, video is on Norseman Nook Facebook page; would like to increase digital reading
