- School Improvement/School LAND Trust Plan: review. We have 3 goals. 2 were set by the district and 1 was set by the school.
 - 1) Increase by 2% the number of students scoring at or above college readiness benchmarks in all 4 (English, math, science, reading - explorer subtests).
 - 2) Decrease the number credit deficient students going in to high school. NDJH: By 4th term NDJH will reduce the number of credit deficient students from 47 to 30. A reduction of 17 students.
 - Interventions to help students receive credit for their classes:
 - 5 block
 - Flextime
 - Lunch bunch

- o 3) Quality staffing. Differentiation of teaching. 15 people went to Las Vegas over the summer for training on differentiation. Those teachers are now sharing that knowledge and training with the other teachers. Goal measurement will be tracked through administrative observations in the classroom. Differenctiation terminology: Responsive teaching rather than one size fits all teaching. Teachers will adapt their lessons to the needs of the students in the class. Quote (Carol Tomlinson): "Teachers proactively plan varyied approaches to what students need to learn, how they will learn it, and/or how they will show what they have learned in order to increase the likelihood that each student will learn as much as he or she can, as efficiently as possible." Professional development: 1st Fri, other Fri is PLC times
